20 **STANDING**

21 The petitioners are beneficiaries under the 2007 settlement
22 agreement signed by Dr. Jürgen-Peter Graf and two of the three
23 plaintiffs on a UK high court order signed by Lord Alan F.
24 Rodgers in May 2011. The dual account numbers representing the
25 plaintiffs on the 2011 UK court order also substantiate our
26 standing in the 2007 settlement agreement. Therefore, we have
27 standing and the need to make our petition to this court.

1 **NATURE OF ACTION**

2 As the result of a 2007 decision of the German Federal
3 Criminal Court 1 signed by Dr. Jürgen-Peter Graf, and the 2011
4 UK high court order signed by Lord Alan F. Rodger, The Federal
5 Republic of Germany, State of Hessen, Frankfurt-am-Main Court of
6 Appeals was charged with, and voluntarily accepted, global
7 jurisdiction and the judicial duty to protect the rights of the
8 beneficiaries and ensure all court decisions are enforced. This
9 acceptance can be substantiated by the computer monitor
10 installed in the office of the president of the Frankfurt-am-
11 Main Court of Appeals per the 2011 UK court order.

13 **PETITIONER REQUEST**

14 Petitioners hereby request the court fulfill its judicial
15 duty by ordering the current court appointed administrator Simon
16 J. Church, a.k.a. Simon Richards, a.k.a. Unknown, to fulfill his
17 fiduciary duties to Petitioners.

18 These duties include:

- 19 1. Notifying all beneficiaries of the current status of the
20 escrows funds.
- 21 2. Notifying all beneficiaries of the current secure claims
22 process.
- 23 3. Allowing all beneficiaries to make claims for funds.
- 24 4. Securing all records related to this matter for review of
25 any and all parties involved, including but not limited to
26 beneficiaries, heirs, legal counsel, and investigators.
- 27 5. Any other duties deemed necessary by the judiciary to
complete performance of court decisions.
